First Amended NOTICE OF FEE CHANGES

Effective July 28, 2009*

As a result of the enactment of Senate Bill (SBX4) 13 (Stats. 2009, ch. 22), various civil filing fees and one criminal (security) fee will be increased as of July 28, 2009*. The additional revenue from the fee increase will be used to offset General Fund reduction to trial court operations.

Fee increases apply to the following:

- \$5 increase to first paper civil filing fees (permanent)
- \$10 increase to filings and services authorized in GC sections 70626(a) and GC 70626(b) (permanent)
- \$10 increase to the \$20 security fee authorized by Penal Code section 1465.8 (sunsets on June 30, 2011)

The new civil fees will be stated on the revised statewide civil fee schedule. The final version of the fee schedule will be posted to the California Courts Web site at www.courtinfo.ca.gov/reference/fceschedule.htm and will also be available at the clerk's office.

* Although the effective date of the fee increase is July 28, 2009, the Superior Courts have been allowed to implement these fees at their earliest convenience. Therefore, the criminal fee increase for Superior Court of California, County of Kings, will be effective August 5, 2009 and the civil fee increase will be effective August 17, 2009.
