**Subject:** Calendar Changes Effective May 15, 2006

Effective Monday, May 15, 2006, numerous calendars changes will take place for the following Superior Court Departments: 5; 7; 8; 9; 10; and, 11.

Department 5 (Judge Orndoff):

- A. All Juvenile 300's and 602's will now be assigned to Department 5.
- B. Juvenile Dependency Matters originally scheduled in Department 11, with hearing dates from May 15, 2006, up to and including August 14, 2006, will be transferred to Department 5. Hearing dates and times will not change with this transfer—only the location will change.
- C. Dependency Matters scheduled after August 15, 2006, will be scheduled according to the new Department 5 Calendar as noted below.
- D. Dependency and Delinquency Matters scheduled from the date of this memorandum will be subject to the new calendar.

**Department 7 (Judge Maciel) and Department 8 (Judge DeSantos):**

Effective May 15, 2006, all currently scheduled and future Hanford and Lemoore Traffic, Limited Civil and Unlawful Detainers will be transferred from Hanford to Lemoore for hearing(s) in Department 11.

The hearing times for these matters will be as follows:

- A) Traffic Trials will be heard in Lemoore on Wednesdays at 3:00 p.m. and any scheduling overflows will be heard at 1:30 p.m. on Thursdays.
- B) Limited Civil and Unlawful Detainers will now be heard in Lemoore at 1:30 p.m. on Thursdays.
- C) Smalls Claims will be heard at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesdays in Lemoore.

**Department 9 (Commissioner Rynda)**

- A) Avenal Limited Civil, Small Claims, Unlawful Detainers, and Traffic Trials, will be heard on the First and Third Wednesdays of the month at 1:30 p.m. in Avenal.
- B) At this time, the Criminal Calendar (Judge DeSantos, presiding) will remain the same as presently scheduled (i.e., in Avenal, on Fridays, beginning at 8:15 a.m.).

**Department 10 \*\*\* (Commissioner Rynda)**

- A) Corcoran Limited Civil, Small Claims, Unlawful Detainers, and Traffic Trials, will be heard on the Second and Fourth Wednesdays of the month in Corcoran at 1:30 p.m.
- B) At this time, the Criminal Calendar (Judge DeSantos, presiding) will remain the same as presently scheduled (i.e., in Corcoran, on Thursdays, beginning at 8:15 a.m.).

**Department 11 (Commissioner Rynda)**

- A) Effective May 15, 2006, all Juvenile Dependency matters will be transferred to Department 5 (Judge Orndoff, presiding) in Hanford.
- B) The Family Law, Adoptions and Probate settings will remain status quo.
- C) Hanford and Lemoore Small Claims and Traffic Trials will be heard on Wednesdays, at 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m., respectively.
- D) Hanford and Lemoore Limited Civil and Unlawful Detainers will be heard on Thursdays at 1:30 p.m.
