STANDING ORDER
TO TERMINATE JUVENILE DEPENDENCY CASE AND OPEN SEPARATE FILE
REGARDING NONMINOR DEPENDENTS PURSUANT TO
W&I CODE SECTION 362.5

To protect the privacy of nonminor dependents and comply with Welfare and Institutions Code section 362.5, the Kings County Superior Court shall maintain separate files for nonminor dependents that continue to remain under the dependency jurisdiction of the Court. To facilitate the termination of dependency cases and the opening of separate files for nonminor dependents, the Human Services Agency shall file with the Court findings and orders with provisions to terminate the dependency matters of all persons under the dependency jurisdiction of the Court when the individual reaches 18 years of age, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and to open a separate matter for nonminor dependents. No notice shall be required, however, all counsel shall be promptly served with the file stamped copy of the signed order.

To protect the nonminor dependents privacy, in instances where reports and other documents were filed in error in the juvenile dependency case, those reports filed after the nonminor's 18th birthday and other documents shall be removed from the juvenile dependency file and filed in the separate nonminor dependency file nunc pro tunc to the original file stamped date.
