REGARDING FILING OF POLICE REPORTS IN DEPENDENCY CASES


The Juvenile Court finds that:

1. Police reports are frequently part of the necessary information in dependency cases.
2. These police reports must be kept confidential so as not to impede investigations.

The Juvenile Court orders that:

1. All police reports filed in dependency cases are to be kept confidential and shall only be distributed to the Juvenile Court and counsel in the dependency action.
2. All police reports filed in dependency actions shall be filed separately with a cover sheet citing this order and kept in the confidential portion of the Juvenile Dependency Court File.
